Course Description and Objectives			This studio addresses urban housing blocks that increase internal urban density rather than expanding the city horizontally. It aims to maintain a balanced ratio of resident and floating populations and to support street—oriented lifestyles. The design target is a mid—to—low—rise, high—density mixed—use housing typology that fulfills urban functions while retaining zoning regulations. Students will design unit blocks with generous outdoor spaces, adequate sunlight, and vibrant commercial zones along the street level. The studio begins with imagining everyday life and explores how it manifests in residential plans, interior space, and urban public space. The lifestyle scenarios are linked to interior organization, building form, streetscape, and urban atmosphere.
